Under the Freedom of Information Act, please could you provide us with the following information:

In the financial years 15/16, 16/17 and 17/18:

- 1. How many grants were awarded to organisations in which at least one of the outcomes was to provide services to victims of stalking?
- 2. What was the total monetary value of these grants?
- 3. Which organisations were awarded?

Response

I write further to your request under the Freedom of Information Act. I set out the responses below on behalf of the OPCC

- 1. In each financial year, 15/16, 16/17 and 17/18, 2 grants were awarded to organisations where the outcome was to provide services to victims of stalking.
- In 2015/16 the total monetary value was £1,053,524 In 2016/17 the total monetary value was £1,071,357 In 2017/18 the total monetary value was £1,071,357
- 3. Victims Support and Refuge were awarded grants in all 3 financial years.
