Can I make an FOI request for the total cost that TVP will be paying to fund the policing of the Royal Wedding in Windsor on Saturday 19th May 2018?

Response

Thank you for your email requesting information about 'policing the Royal Wedding' under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The final cost of policing the Royal Wedding will not be known for several weeks as we wait for final invoices and overtime claims etc. to come in.

However, a final estimate of expected costs was produced on 4th May and this showed a gross cost of £2.082m. We will, of course, be seeking grant assistance from the Home Office but their financial contribution will not be known until much later in this financial year since we will be rolling up several major policing operations and seeking one combined grant award.
