The OPCC can confirm that the PCC and TVP Chief Constable also hold private Level: liaison meetings, which provide them with an opportunity to discuss topical local or national matters as necessary in a less formal setting. These meetings are not open to the public. It may also assist you to know that on page 113 of the agenda papers for the Level 1 meeting due to be held on 25th July 2019 (which can be found on the below link), the 4th paragraph from the bottom refers to the arrangements by which the PCC holds the Chief Constable to account. This can also be found on page 3 of the 'Annual Governance Statement 2018/19' which is included as an appendix (Agenda item 8) in the agenda papers.

Section 21(1) Information Reasonably Accessible By Other Means
Section 21 is an absolute class based exemption and does not require a public interest test.
